Tuition Fees

The total tuition for the coming year is \$20,000 (not including \$750 registration fee).

The payment schedule for tuition is as follows:

An application fee of \$50 must accompany each application. Once you receive a letter of acceptance, a \$750 non-refundable registration fee will ensure your place in the Yeshiva. This fee is required even if you are on a college program.

NOTE: No student can be guaranteed a space in our dormitory without this registration fee.

The balance of tuition, \$20,000 should be sent to our American office by August 15, 2018.

Check #1 dated September 1st 2018 in the amount of \$10,000

Check #2 dated January 1st 2019 in the amount of \$10,000

All checks should be made payable to Ohr David Outreach. Your cancelled check is receipt of payment.

No student will be admitted to the school or dormitory facilities unless financial arrangements have been completed.



Short, school sponsored tours are included in the tuition fee. *There are two longer tours* (3-4 days) to the North and the South not included in the tuition. These tours are mandatory and the cost is \$350 per tour. Please send two post-dated checks to our New York office along with the tuition payment.

College Options

Yeshivat Ohr David has a joint program with Yeshiva University, Touro College, and Hebrew Theological College (Skokie Yeshiva). Students who plan to be on the joint program must apply and be accepted by the respective college and inform them that you plan to study in Israel at Yeshivat Ohr David. Upon acceptance to the college program please inform the Yeshiva of your intent and send us a copy of your acceptance letter. You can apply for financial aid via the Joint Israel programs.

Financial Aid

MASA: All students will be eligible for a minimum of \$1,000 and up to a \$4,000 grant through the MASA organization. Plesae contact our office for further information.
